A Win for Wyoming Coal!

Last Wednesday, the 9th Circuit Court of Appeals ruled in Wyoming's favor in a lawsuit of immense importance for our State, western coal, and the entire country. For years, the Biden and Obama administrations, radical enviro-activists, and far-left states have tried to weaponize the courts against clean, affordable, reliable energy: in 2016 President Obama placed a moratorium on federal coal leasing, a policy which President Trump reversed. Yet in 2022, this moratorium was reinstated when an Obama-appointed judge imposed an unlawful and unprecedented injunction on all federal coal leasing, not only far exceeding his authority, but legislating from the bench.


This new ruling from the 9th Circuit lifts that improperly imposed moratorium and dismissed the lawsuit brought by groups like the Sierra Club, WildEarth Guardians, and the states of California, New York, and Washington. It will allow important projects to go forward, most specifically those projects that improve our energy security, decrease energy poverty, and provide us with those resources we need in a modern society. This decision will should provide an immense economic benefit for Wyoming and the west at large. This is a significant step toward restoring America's energy security, combatting President Biden's energy poverty agenda, and creating greater economic investment and opportunity in Wyoming's communities.

Updated US Passport Processing Times

Passport processing times have returned to normal, but it is still important to plan ahead if you have upcoming international travel plans! Routine passport processing is currently at **6-8 weeks**, while expedited requests will take **2-3 weeks**. Remember that it may also take up to 2 weeks for applications to arrive at the agency and another 2 weeks for your passport to reach your house. Please plan accordingly!



Protecting Ranch Vehicles, Work Trucks, and Daily Drivers

The Biden Administration continues to vilify internal combustion engines (ICE) in its effort to prop up the unsustainable electric vehicle (EV) industry. While EVs may be a good choice for some people in megacities, they cannot withstand the demands of long-distance driving in a Wyoming winter or meet the needs and demands of our ranching, farming, mining, and other industries. You are entitled to purchase an affordable and reliable vehicle that suits your family's situation and budget, not be forced into the electrical vehicle market by the radical Biden Administration and rogue D.C. bureaucrats. Here are some of the ways I'm fighting against Biden's war on ICE vehicles:

- [I just signed a bipartisan letter](#) to President Biden and OMB Director Young demanding they block the Environmental Protection Agency's absurd new tailpipe emissions standards. If enacted, 67% of new light-duty and 46% of medium-duty vehicles must be electric by 2032.
- Two weeks ago, [I co-introduced the UNPLUG EV's Act](#) with Rep. Burlison (R-MO). This bill expands on my effort last year to defund the Biden Administration's failed National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure (NEVI) Program and would rescind NEVI and the Charging and Fueling Infrastructure (CFI) grant program that have already wasted billions of taxpayer dollars on EV charging stations with no tangible results. These programs simply subsidize an industry that lacks adequate demand nationwide, is dependent on Chinese-sourced minerals and materials, and will endanger our already overtaxed power grid.
- I've sent letters to [congressional leaders](#) and [agency officials](#) opposing the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's (NHTSA) new Corporate Average Fuel Economy (CAFE) Standards that create absurd fuel economy requirements, falsely inflate the estimated fuel economy value of EVs while minimizing their actual carbon footprint, and far exceed NHTSA's legal authority.

USPS Still Accepting Comments on Casper Facility Relocation

My staff attended the USPS public meeting this week to provide input on plans to relocate the Casper Processing and Distribution Center to Billings, MT, and over one hundred of you showed up to voice your concerns as well. Moving this facility out of Wyoming poses a grave threat to our ability to receive our medications, to pay our bills, to receive our packages, and to conduct our elections.

I will continue working with Senators Barrasso and Lummis to address these concerns in Washington, but we need your help. You can share your concerns and public comments on the USPS plan up to **March 7** [via this link](#).

Cosponsored Legislation

Here are some highlights of [bills I'm cosponsoring](#):

1. [H.R. 6758](#), the *Defense of Property Rights Act*, which establishes a uniform, efficient process to protect property owners' rights guaranteed by the Fifth Amendment.
2. [H.R. 7273](#), the *UNPLUG EVs Act*, which ends funding for the Biden Administration's failed National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure (NEVI) and Charging and Fueling Infrastructure (CFI) programs.
3. [H.R. 7280](#), the *HUD Transparency Act*, which requires the Inspector General for the Department of Housing and Urban Development to testify before Congress annually.
4. [H.R. 7322](#), the *Standing Up to the Executive branch for Immigration Enforcement (SUE for Immigration Enforcement) Act*, which allows states to sue the federal government for damages resulting from its failure to enforce immigration laws and secure the border.

On Friday I visited Evanston's Early Childhood Development Center, which provides top-tier childcare and education for young children of an astounding 400 families across Uinta County.







