## Working to Curb Inflation

While the holidays are a time in which we give thanks, they are also often a difficult reminder of the challenges so many Americans are facing due to inflation. According to the [American Farm Bureau's annual Thanksgiving dinner survey](#), while the cost of a Thanksgiving dinner has dropped since last year, it is still 19% higher than pre-pandemic levels. Although the cost of a turkey has decreased by 6.1% since 2023, the cost of dinner rolls and fresh cranberries have spiked dramatically, at 8.4% and 11.8%, respectively.

I was disheartened to see that Wyoming has been especially hard-hit by the increasing prices, with Thanksgiving dinner being named the least affordable here in the West—approximately \$10 higher than other regions of the nation. Despite this news, I have hope that common sense will be restored in D.C. when President Trump takes office in January. As your representative, I look forward to working with him and a united Congress to rein in out-of-control government spending and make life more affordable for all Americans.
