Hello Laura,

I was thankful to be back in Wyoming last week attending Memorial Day events across the state honoring our nation's fallen heroes. It is important that we never forget those who laid down their lives to safeguard the freedoms we hold so dear.

I was also happy to host a town hall in Converse County on Friday, where I was able to update those in attendance on the work I have been doing as your lone representative in Congress and answer questions from constituents. Thank you to all who attended my town hall and to those who helped make it a success.

President Trump's Sham Trial Yields a Sham Verdict

On Thursday, justice was NOT served in the New York State Supreme Court trial of former President Donald Trump. Manhattan District Attorney Alvin Bragg and Judge Juan Merchan used [lawfare in a serious escalation of government weaponization](#). Every step of this case exposed how it was an act of election interference and an attack on political opposition. DA Bragg was elected promising to prosecute Donald Trump. He then resurrected a zombie case using a novel legal theory, on-boarded a "former" Biden DOJ official and DNC operative as the lead prosecutor, and tried the case before Judge Merchan who donated to President Biden and the Democratic Party during the 2020 election and whose daughter – a Democrat political consultant -- has made over \$9 million from the Biden/Harris campaign alone (not to mention her work for people like Adam Schiff and Dan Goldman).

The bottom line is that Democrats know that President Biden cannot fairly or on the strength of his dismal record defeat President Trump. They have thus resorted to abusing government power through rogue impeachments, prosecutions, and this bogus, rigged verdict. DA Bragg brought this case after the statute of limitations had passed and elevated it to a felony based upon a theory that was never disclosed until the jury instructions were given. Judge Merchan blocked key witnesses, testimony, and facts offered by the defense, while allowing the prosecution to introduce scandalous and irrelevant "evidence," while elevating the profile of a convicted perjurer and admitted thief. The judge then read 50 pages of slanted, legally insufficient and constitutionally suspect instructions to the jury prior to its deliberations. Rest assured, I will continue to stand with President Trump as he fights this battle and as this conviction is ultimately overturned on appeal.

Demanding Answers from USFWS on its Failure to Delist Grizzlies

On Tuesday, I led a letter to the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) demanding answers as to why USFWS has refused to delist the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem (GYE) grizzly bear population from the endangered species list. The State of Wyoming filed a petition for judicial review in the Wyoming Federal District Court, alleging that the Department of the Interior (DOI) and USFWS "failed to meet the 12-month deadline for determining Wyoming's petition to delist the grizzly bear population in the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem." Guidelines set under the Endangered Species Act (ESA) require these agencies to issue their findings "within 12 months after receiving a petition." The USFWS, however, has exceeded this deadline by more than 18 months and is in direct violation of the ESA. You can view my full letter [here](#). The GYE Grizzlies have more than fully recovered, and USFWS's failure to delist them poses a grave threat to humans, livestock and other wildlife. As your representative, I will continue to fight back against DC bureaucrats who think they know how to best manage Wyoming's wildlife, when in reality the state should be responsible for management of the GYE grizzly population. That is why I introduced [H.R. 1245](#), the Grizzly Bear State Management Act, which would require the DOI to remove the GYE grizzly bear population from the endangered species list.

My Priorities for Fiscal Year 2025 Appropriations Cycle: Pt. 2

Fire-EMS Fire Station 1 Reconstruction Project - City of Casper, WY

The funding for this project will be used to purchase land and enter into a contract for the engineering and design phase of the Casper Fire-EMS Station 1 replacement project. This critical project will promote the safety of our Casper citizens, provide better facilities for first responders to promote their physical and mental well-being, and result in long-term cost savings for taxpayers by mitigating expensive maintenance needs at the existing facility.

Jackson Hole Airport Deice Pad Improvements – Jackson Hole Airport (JAC)

The funding for this project will be used to complete Phase 2 of the Deice Pad Improvements, increasing both safety and operational efficiency. Making these critical improvements to aircraft deicing operations and collection systems will reduce aircraft dwell, delay, and taxi times, improve regional and national reliability and safety, and continue to support economic development within Wyoming.

Sanitary Sewer Improvements Project – City of Mills, WY

This funding would go towards replacing sanitary sewer systems at three locations throughout the City of Mills that are significantly corroded and lack adequate capacity. Replacing the aging sewer system elements will ensure that the City can properly handle sewer water and guarantee the health of residents and the environment. The project will also reduce long-term maintenance costs and mitigate the risk of costly sewer line breaks in the future.

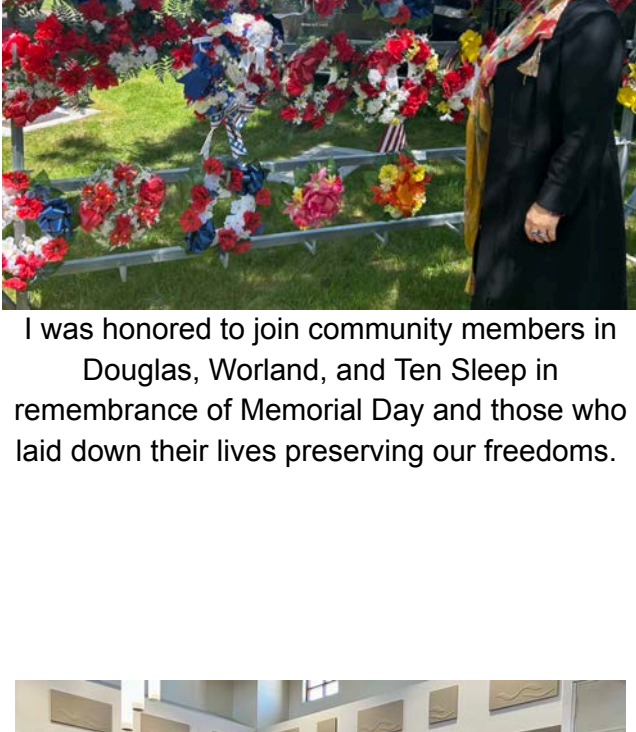

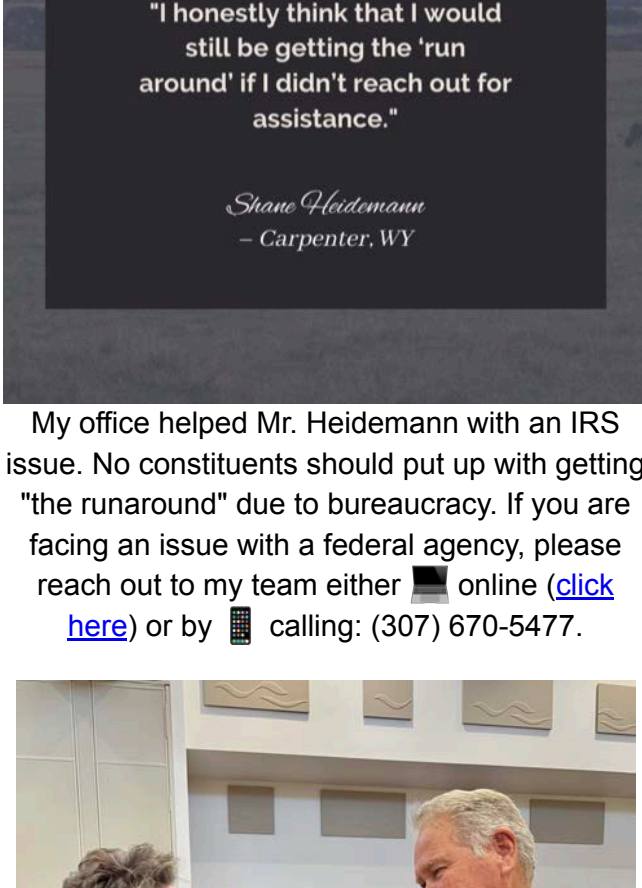

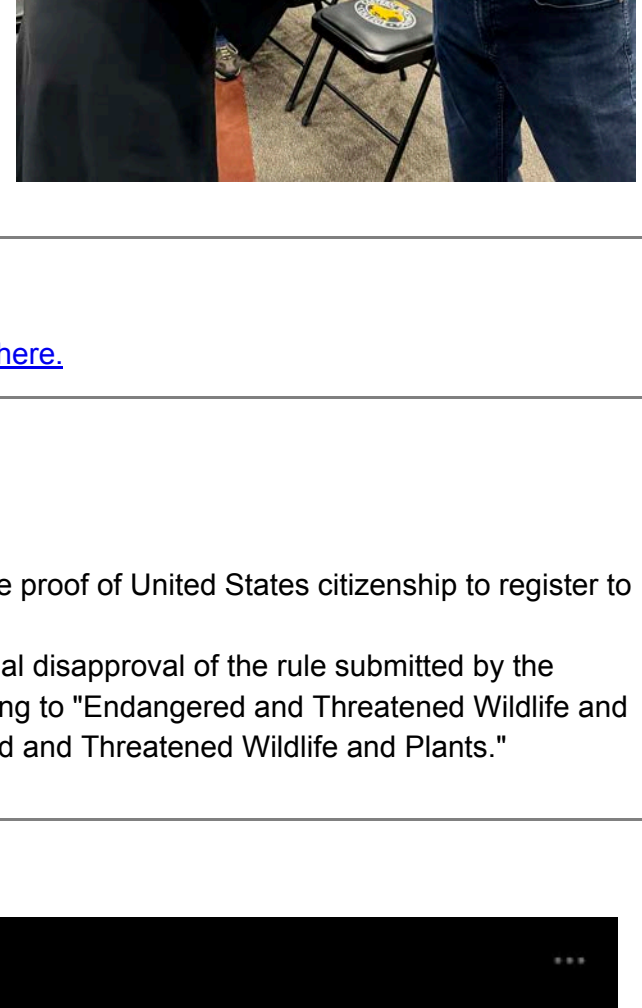
I was honored to join community members in Douglas, Worland, and Ten Sleep in remembrance of Memorial Day and those who laid down their lives preserving our freedoms.

Here are some highlights of [bills I'm cosponsoring](#):

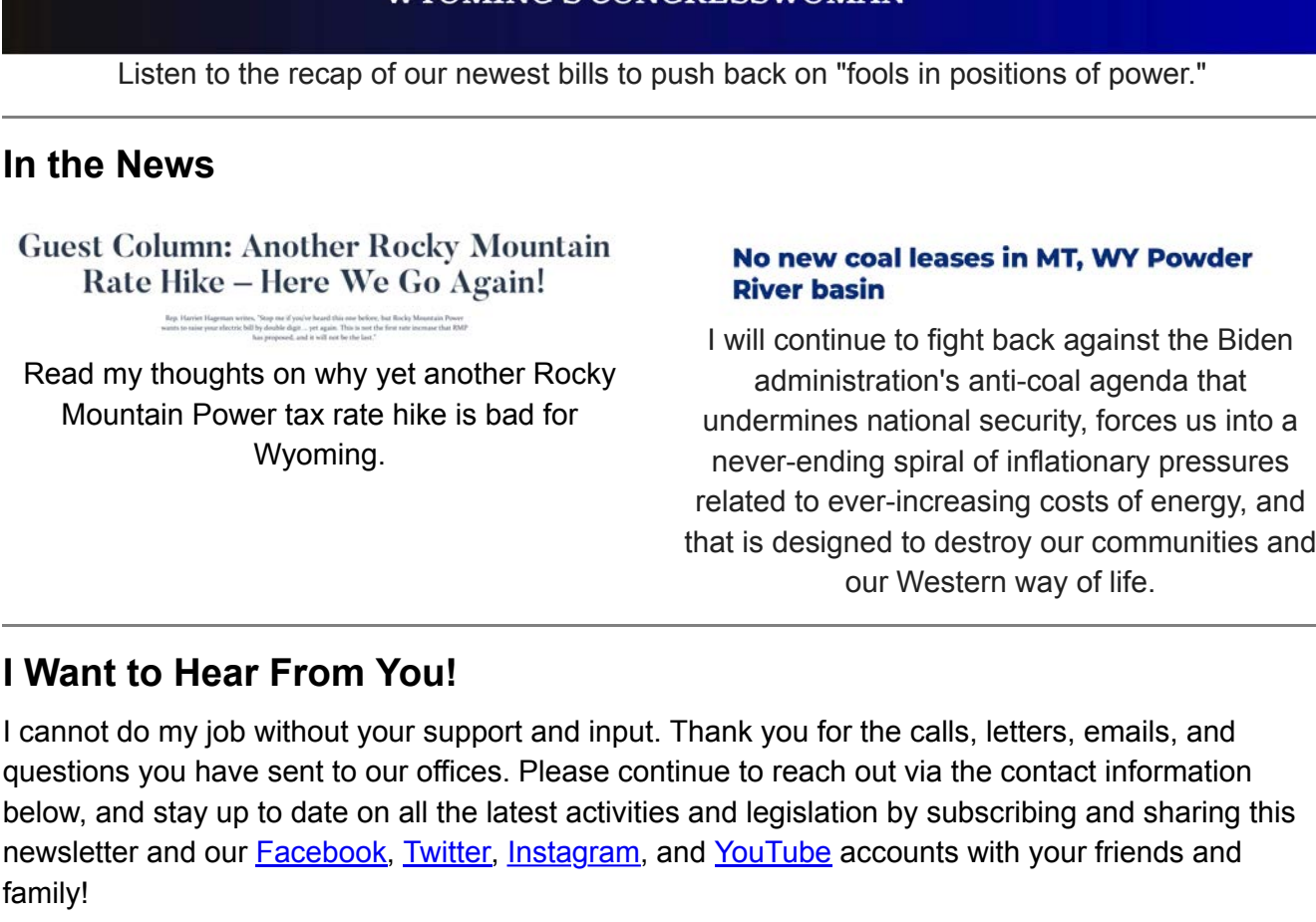
- [H.R. 8281](#), the SAVE Act, which would require proof of United States citizenship to register to vote in elections for federal office.
