Dear Chairwoman Granger and Ranking Member DeLauro,


I am requesting funding for the North Platte Sanitary Sewer Phase II Project, Casper, WY (WY-at Large) in fiscal year 2024. The entity receiving the funding for this project is the City of Casper located at 200 N David St, Casper, WY 82601. The funding for this project will be used for Phase II of the project rehabilitating the North Platte Sanitary Sewer Interceptor. This includes 1.1 miles of concrete sewer pipe to be lined with a cured in place lining, replacing seven manholes, and rehabilitating eleven manholes.

This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars because the project will provide essential services to the low and moderate-income residents of Natrona County. More than 40% of residents of Natrona County are low and moderate-income (making less than 80% AMI) and communities served by the infrastructure are majority low/moderate income (City of Mills is 64% low-income and the Town of Evansville is 69%). Rehabilitating the sanitary sewer infrastructure will extend the life of the regional system assets, encourage economic development, and provide environmental protection. The project is critical to maintain affordable sewer rates for several low-income communities within Natrona County. The preliminary design and specifications have been completed to a 90% level and can be finished and permitted over just a couple of months.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2)
