Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the 19th Street and Missile Drive Intersection Realignment Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Cheyenne, located at 2101 O'Neil Avenue, Cheyenne, WY 82001. The funding would be used for the construction of a multi-span bridge over Crow Creek and the reconfiguration of the 19th Street and Missile Drive intersection by realigning 19th Street to create a 90-degree connection. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because replacing the bridge and realigning the intersection at 19th Street and Missile Drive will mitigate flood hazards, improve traffic conditions, promote safety, and support economic development along the Missile Drive corridor.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133.
