Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the Lower Mills Hydrant, Service, and Valve Replacement Project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Mills, located at 704 Fourth Street, Mills, WY 82604. The funding would be used to replace aging and dysfunctional fire hydrants, mainline valves, and service saddles in Lower Mills. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will ensure continued water service to the homes and businesses in the area, guarantee that Fire personnel have access to working hydrants to effectively respond to emergency events, conduct replacement of critical water infrastructure for Mills residents, and reduce long-term maintenance costs and mitigate the risk of costly waterline breaks in the future.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
