Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the City of Mills for Lower Mills Hydrant, Service, and Valve Replacement Phase 2 in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Mills, located at 704 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Mills, WY 82644. The funding would be used for the replacement of aging and dysfunctional fire hydrants, main line valves, and service saddles in Lower Mills. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will support continued water service to the homes and businesses in the area, ensure that Fire personnel have access to working hydrants to effectively respond to emergency events, reduce long-term maintenance costs, and mitigate the risk of costly waterline breaks in the future.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
