Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the City of Torrington Solid Waste Baler Facility Construction Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Torrington, WY, located at 436 East 22nd Avenue, Torrington, WY 82240. The funding would be used to construct a new municipal solid waste transfer station, replacing the current baler facility located within the City of Torrington's corporate boundary, which is approximately 5 miles from the city's landfill. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will replace an aged, obsolete system, contributing to cleaner and more efficient operations, while ensuring the continuation of these vital disposal services to multiple rural Wyoming communities, with the possibility of future expansion.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under Section 306 of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, 7 U.S. Code section 1926(a)(2).
