Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the Crook County Sheriff's Office Vehicle Acquisition Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Crook County Sheriff's Office, located at 309 Cleveland Street, Sundance, WY 82729. The funding would be used to purchase two new patrol trucks, a third truck to be utilized by Emergency Management within the Sheriff's office, and associated equipment upgrades, including cages, radar units, radios, in-car cameras, and other outdated equipment that would have to be used. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the current vehicle fleet is old and outdated, having over 150,000 miles and reaching the end of its service life, while also ensuring that effective law enforcement and emergency management coverage can continue across multiple rural communities in Crook County, Wyoming.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under section 1701(b)(9) of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10381(b)(9)).
