Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the 911 Communications and Dispatch Systems Upgrades Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Sweetwater Combined Communications Joint Powers Board, located at 5 Shoshone Avenue, Green River, WY 82935. The funding would be used to support the replacement of two critical communications systems that are approaching "end-of-life" status in the next two years. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will replace aging, unsupported public safety-related infrastructure and ensure the continuous operation of critical emergency communications and 911 services for rural Wyoming residents.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in section 501 of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10152).
