Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the Southwest Wyoming Regional Airport (RKS) General Aviation Apron Rehabilitation and Expansion Project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Southwest Wyoming Regional Airport (RKS), located at 382 WY-370, Rock Springs, WY 82901. The funding would be used for both urgent pavement rehabilitation to accommodate the stress from larger aircraft and the infilling of the space between the general aviation apron and Taxiway E, strategically extending southeast pavement to meet the essential minimum requirements for proper Taxiway Object Free Area clearance, which is pivotal for accommodating increased traffic and optimizing the parking configuration for the diverse fleet mix utilizing the airport.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 49 U.S.C. 47100 et seq.
