I am requesting funding for the US 287 Pavement Rehabilitation – Lander to Fort Washakie Project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Wyoming Department of Transportation, located at 5300 Bishop Blvd., Cheyenne, WY 82009.

The funding would be used for pavement rehabilitation across an 8-mile stretch of US 287 between Lander and Fort Washakie in Fremont County, WY, resulting in improved pavement condition, safety, ride quality, and overall level of service.
