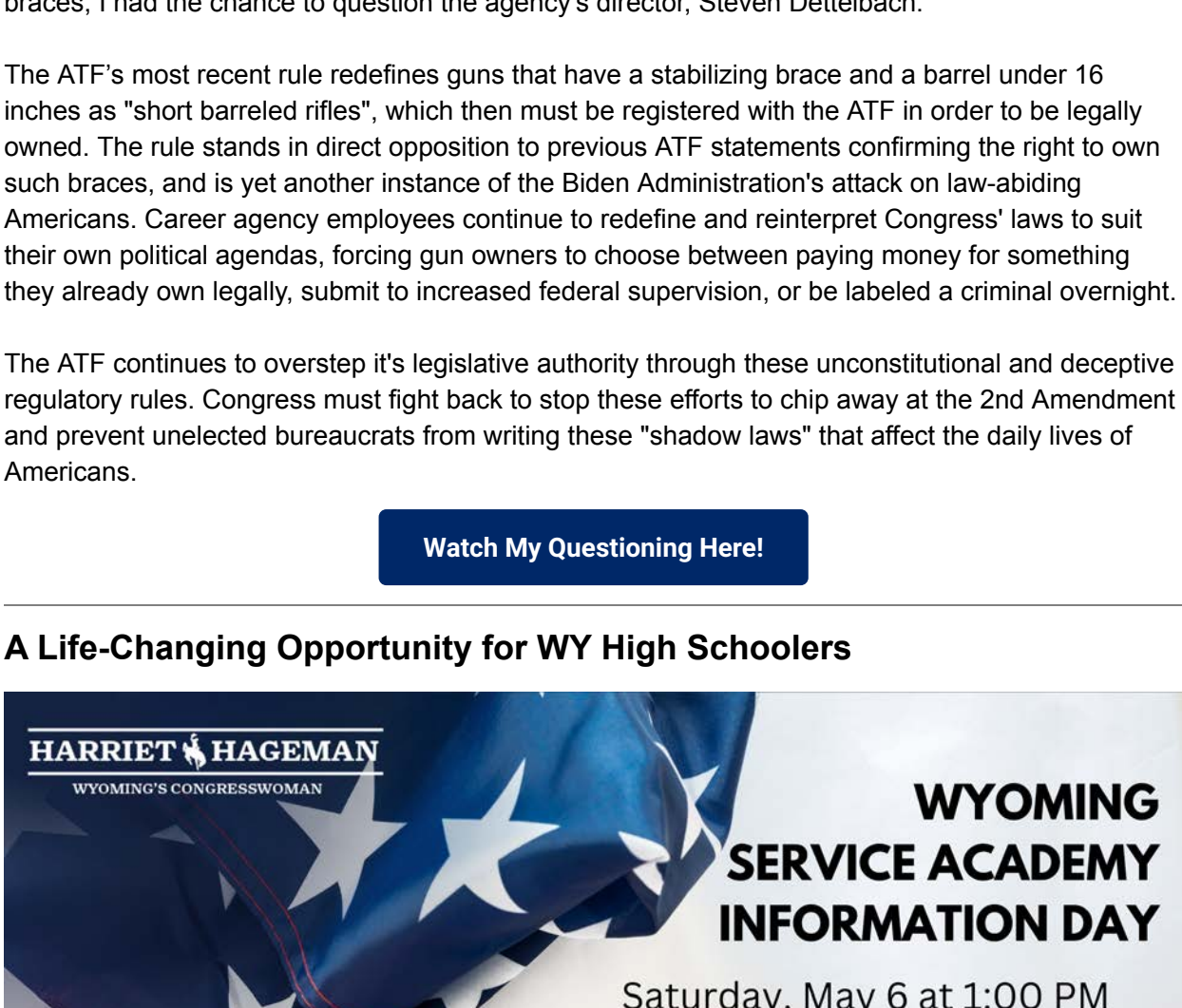
PASSED! The Limit, Save, Grow Act

On April 26, the House of Representatives passed a federal spending bill that will rein in the administrative state and put America back on the path to energy independence. The Limit, Save, Grow Act – will return America to FY 2022 spending levels, reduce nearly \$5 trillion dollars in wasteful spending, and invest in a resilient, flourishing economy.

Highlights of the bill include:

- The entirety of HR 1 – ensuring energy independence and national security
- Defunding Biden's IRS Army
- Clawing back unused COVID-19 funds
- Lowering energy costs
- Ensuring that federal benefits are reserved for working Americans
- Preserving veteran benefits, Medicaid, and Social Security

The ATF Wants Your Guns and Will Make You a Criminal to Get Them

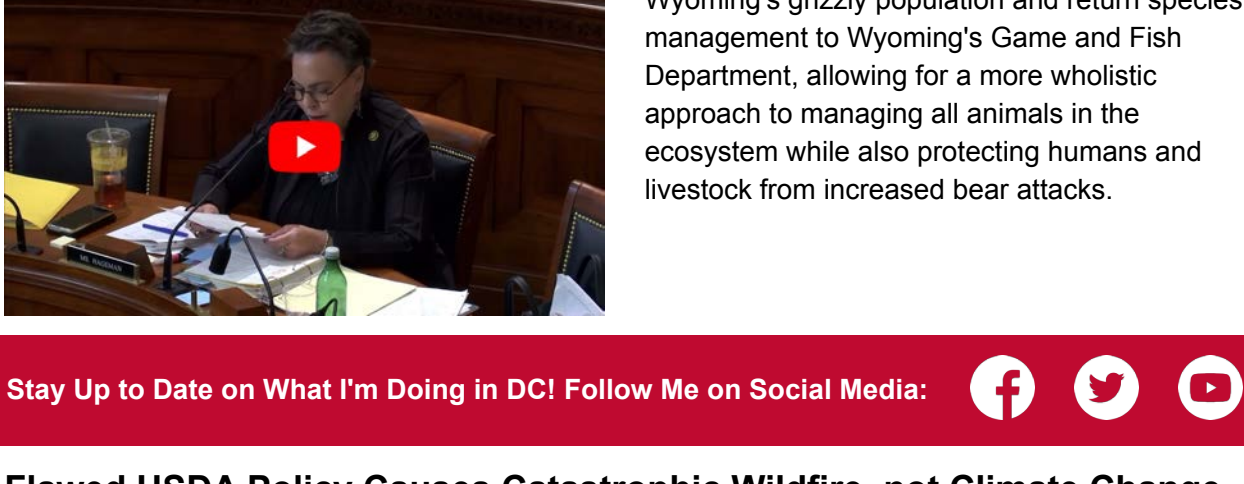
During a House Judiciary Committee hearing on the ATF's latest rule seeking to outlaw pistol braces, I had the chance to question the agency's director, Steven Dettelbach.

The ATF's most recent rule redefines guns that have a stabilizing brace and a barrel under 16 inches as "short barreled rifles", which then must be registered with the ATF in order to be legally owned. The rule stands in direct opposition to previous ATF statements confirming the right to own such braces, and is yet another instance of the Biden Administration's attack on law-abiding Americans. Career agency employees continue to redefine and reinterpret Congress' laws to suit their own political agendas, forcing gun owners to choose between paying money for something they already own legally, submit to increased federal supervision, or be labeled a criminal overnight.

The ATF continues to overstep it's legislative authority through these unconstitutional and deceptive regulatory rules. Congress must fight back to stop these efforts to chip away at the 2nd Amendment and prevent unelected bureaucrats from writing these "shadow laws" that affect the daily lives of Americans.

A Life-Changing Opportunity for WY High Schoolers



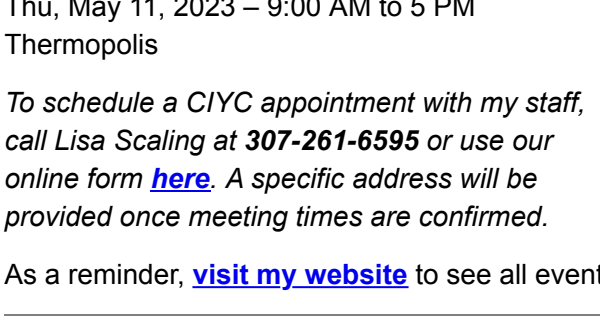
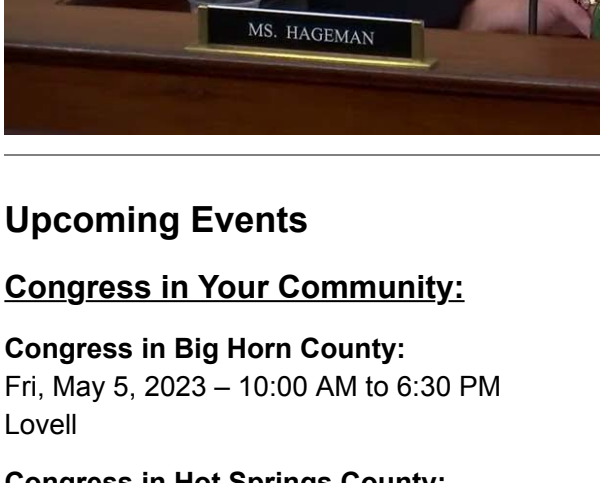

An Update on H.R. 1245 – The Grizzly Bear State Management Act



I was proud to introduce the Grizzly Bear State Management Act and am even more proud that it has officially been passed by the Natural Resources Committee and is now heading to the full House of Representatives!

In 2003, the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem grizzly bear surpassed it's recovery goal under the Endangered Species Act. Yet 20 years later, it is still unnecessarily labeled as "threatened" due to bureaucratic intervention and lawsuits from environmental activists.

This bill recognizes the successful recovery of Wyoming's grizzly population and return species management to Wyoming's Game and Fish Department, allowing for a more holistic approach to managing all animals in the ecosystem while also protecting humans and livestock from increased bear attacks.

Flawed USDA Policy Causes Catastrophic Wildfire, not Climate Change

Climate activists and leftist spokesmen are quick to claim that climate change is destroying our forests through devastating wildfires, but the reality is much simpler. USDA policies such as the Roadless Rule claim to preserve our wilderness, but instead hamper our ability to thin forests, treat invasive and destructive species like the Rocky Mountain Region Bark Beetle, and rapidly respond to wildfires when they first begin.

As if these counterintuitive regulations weren't enough, the US Forest Service excluded Wyoming from their wildfire mitigation plans. It is as if government is always trying to fix its last solution with additional regulations, causing the ball to simply role further down the hill. Much like the true cause of wildfires that have devastated the West, the end state of such constant and misled intervention is simple: taxpayer money is wasted, illogical policies are forced into effect, and American lives and property are put at risk.

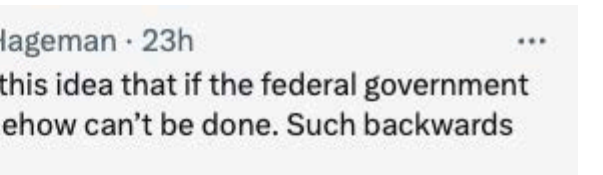

It was a busy week for WY high schoolers! South High School showed up in force!



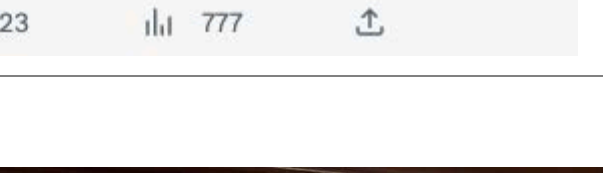

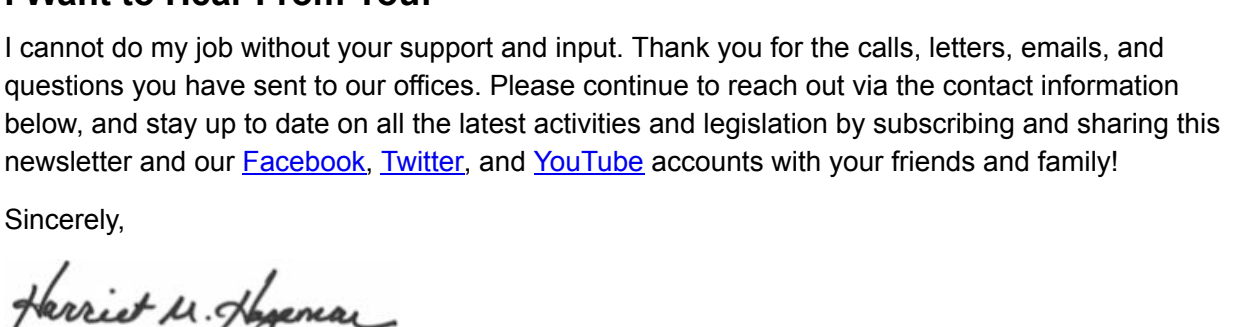
- Voted **YES** on H. Res. 90, *Demanding that the Government of the People's Republic of China and the Communist Party of China immediately release Mark Swidan*
- Voted **YES** on H. Res. 311, which encourages the expansion and strengthening of the Abraham Accords and normalizing of relations with Israel
- Voted **YES** on H.R. 1353, the **ALERT Party Act**, which ensures 9-1-1 access and emergency alert services for underserved mobile service areas
- Voted **YES** on H.R. 2811, the **Limit, Save, Grow Act**
- Voted **YES** on H.R. 1339, the **Precision Agriculture Satellite Connectivity Act**

Cosponsored Legislation

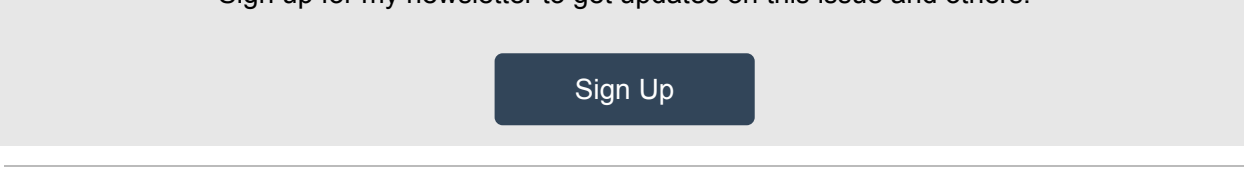
Here are some highlights of [bills I'm cosponsoring](#):

- **H.R. 421**, the **Teleabortion Prevention Act of 2023**, which prohibits chemical abortions performed without a healthcare provider present
- **H.R. 450**, the **Repeal the NFA Act**
- **H.R. 451**, the **Protecting Families from Fertility Fraud Act**, which makes it a crime to knowingly misrepresent the nature or source of DNA used in assisted reproduction
- **H.R. 464**, the **Separation of Powers Restoration Act**, which seeks to limit the Executive Branch's growing overreach and restore the powers and oversight of the Legislative Branch
- **H.R. 494**, the **Defund EcoHealth Alliance Act**
- **H.R. 497**, the **Freedom for Health Care Workers Act**, which eliminates the COVID vaccine requirement for health care workers employed at facilities that receive Medicare and Medicaid funds
- **H.R. 531**, the **Educational Choice for Children Act**, creating a new tax credit for donations to organizations that provide elementary or secondary school scholarships
- **H.R. 558**, which will prevent foreign nations from buying land or property near sensitive sites, such as ports, military facilities, and other places relevant to national security.

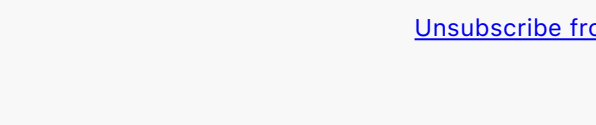

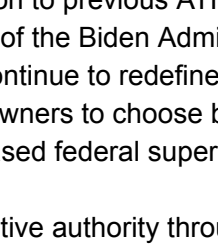
