Standing Up for Wyoming Communities

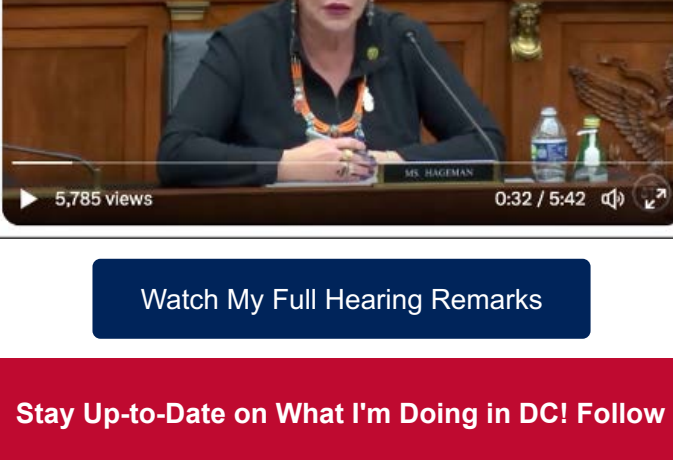
This Thursday, Senators Lummis, Barrasso and I partnered together to introduce the **Protecting Our Wealth of Energy Resources (POWER) Act** in both the House and Senate. This bill would prevent the Biden Administration from stopping or delaying energy and mineral leases for federal lands without congressional approval. It also would require the President to obtain approval before withdrawing federal land from mining and geothermal leasing agreements.

Wyoming is one of the leading energy producers in the nation; it's only fitting that Wyoming would also lead efforts to protect our nation's ability to produce that energy. I would also like to thank the 15 original cosponsors in the House who signed on to support this legislation.

I also introduced **H.R. 922 Reprioritizing Unserved Rural Areas and Locations for (RURAL) Broadband Act of 2023**. This bill will prevent big-city representatives from robbing rural and underserved areas of funds for building much-needed broadband infrastructure allotted through the Rural Utilities Service. Reliable internet access is vital to our lives, and this will be a first step in ensuring residents of Wyoming's rural and Tribal areas receive equal access as those in more populated areas. 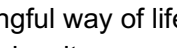

Disaster Resources for Ranchers and Farmers

Farmers and ranchers form the backbone of Wyoming culture; it's a uniquely meaningful way of life that must be experienced to be understood. It is not easy, and that is part of what makes it so rewarding. My office is working with the USDA Farm Service Agency, Wool Growers Association, and WY Department of Agriculture to issue a state of emergency for Southern Wyoming to help lighten the burden imposed by drought and recent severe weather. Below are some resources available to affected Wyomingites through USDA:

- [Emergency Livestock Assistance Program \(ELAP\)](#) – Assist producers with blizzard/winter storm/extreme cold additional feed purchases and snow removal and/or drought feed, livestock, and water transportation costs.
- [Livestock Indemnity Program \(LIP\)](#) – Assist producers with livestock losses
- [Livestock Forage Program \(LFP\)](#) – Assist producers with drought grazing losses
- Livestock Inventory Record Keeping – Ensure your livestock inventory records are up to date in order to provide documentation of your death, grazing, or feed losses in order to receive all assistance you are eligible for.

Cosponsored Legislation

Here are some highlights of [new bills I'm cosponsoring](#):

- Cosponsor for **H.Con.Res.13 Supporting the Local Radio Freedom Act**. This bill states that Congress shouldn't impose any new fees or taxes on local radio stations for broadcasting of sound recordings.
- Cosponsor for **H.R. 932**, a bipartisan bill repealing the 1991 and 2002 Congressional authorizations for the use of military force in Iraq.
- Cosponsor for **H.Res.115 Establishing a Women's Bill of Rights to reaffirm legal protections to women under Federal law**, which will ensure protections for women by clarifying who qualifies as a "woman".

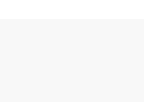
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
