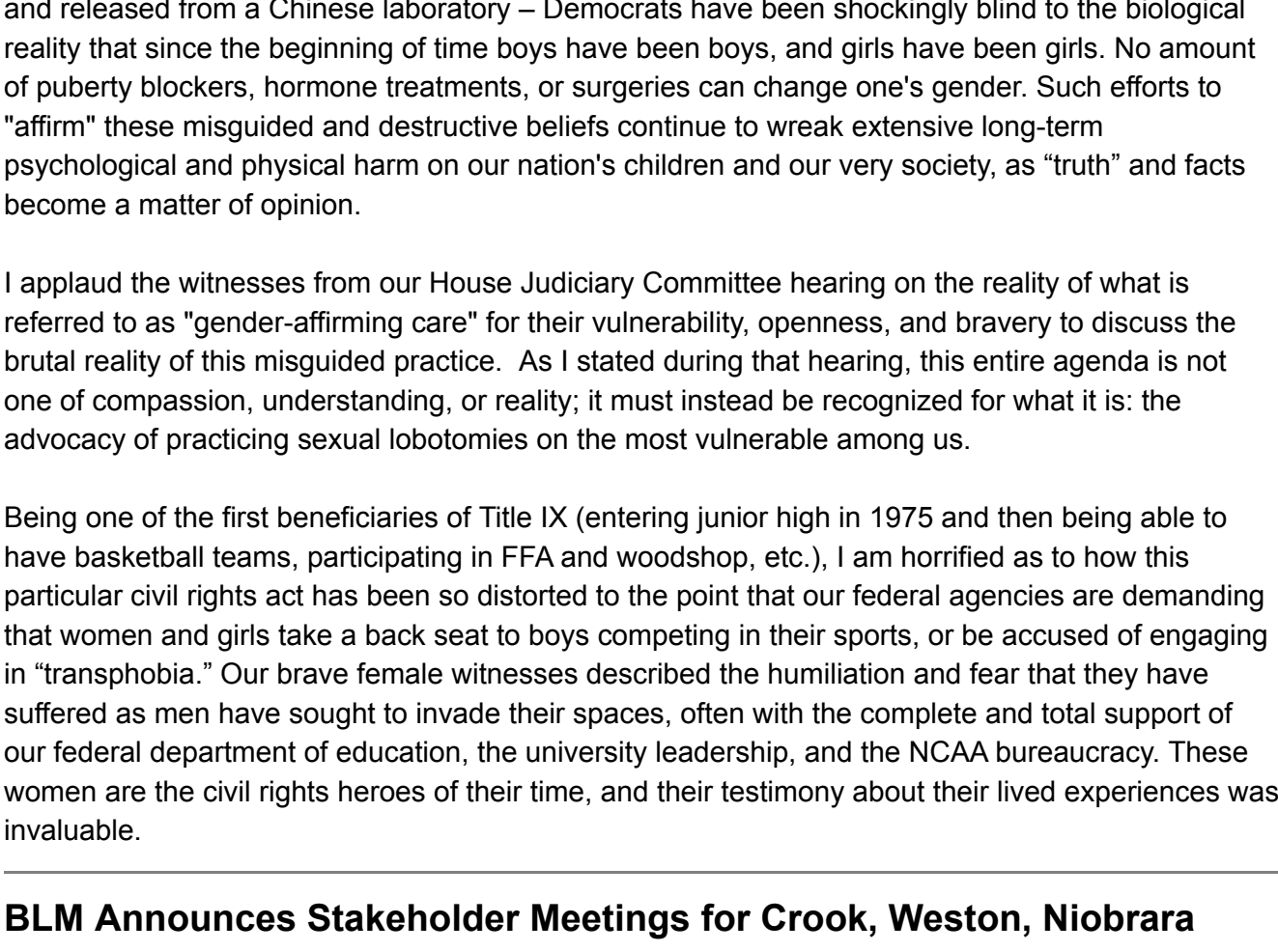
Exposing the Lies of DHS Secretary Mayorkas

Our brave female witnesses described the humiliation and fear that they have suffered as men have sought to invade their spaces, often with the complete and total support of our federal department of education, the university leadership, and the NCAA bureaucracy. 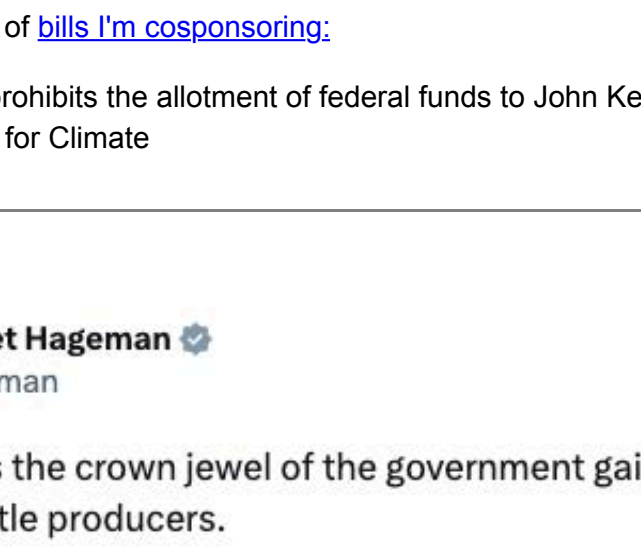

Upcoming Travel Plans? Make Sure Your Passport Is Valid!



At this time, the State Department's standard processing time for passport renewals is **10-13 weeks**. Expedited passport renewal time is approximately **7-9 weeks**. If you have had a trip abroad arise, or for some reason need assistance in a last-minute passport renewal, my office may be able to help. For trips less than 14 days away, please contact my office immediately so we can work with the State Department to obtain a new or renewed passport.

Please note that we cannot guarantee a positive outcome in all cases, and the best way to ensure your trip is "smooth sailing" is to plan ahead and submit your documentation at least 3 months in advance of your scheduled departure.

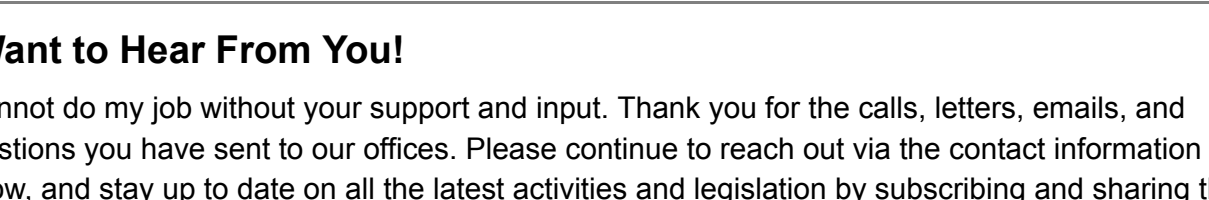
- Voted **NO** on [H.R. 1338](#), the *Satellite and Telecommunications Streamlining Act*.

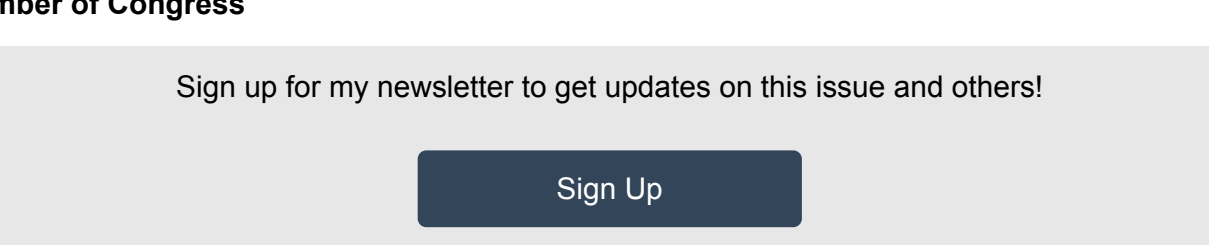
