The Bipartisan Effort to Counter China

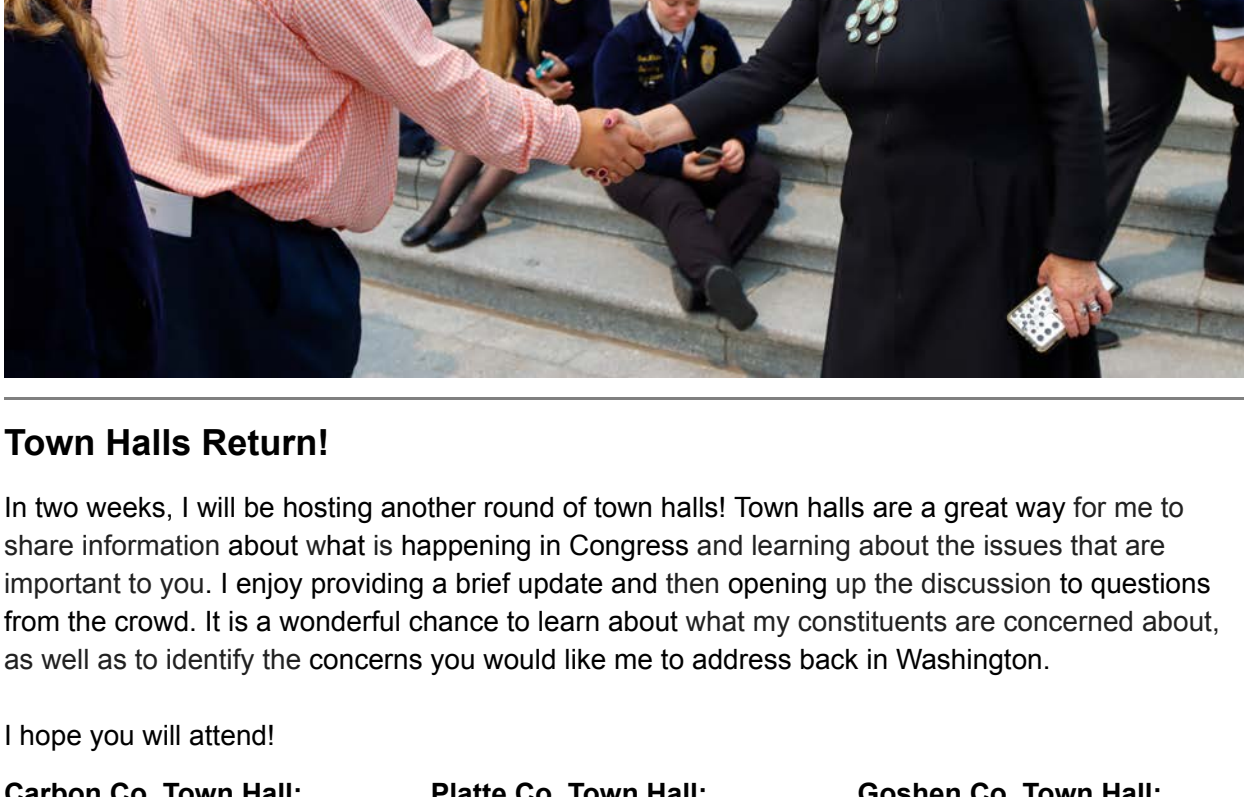
The danger China poses to global security and American prosperity continues to grow, and will become increasingly threatening to regional stability for the foreseeable future. China is working to expand its influence in the Pacific through coercive tactics and promises of untold riches if the south Pacific islands will only follow their lead, borrow lots of money, and mortgage their critical infrastructure. We must therefore meet their latent aggression and malign influence with a sound comprehensive policy and work to counter them economically, politically, and ideologically. The south Pacific islands are critically important to our national security and to blocking China's efforts. I am proud to have joined the Natural Resources Committee's bipartisan Indo-Pacific Task Force created to protect American security.

This task force is composed of equal numbers of Republicans and Democrats, and representatives from America's three Pacific territories (American Samoa, Guam and the Northern Mariana Islands). We are developing and advancing ideas to protect our nation's security and economic interests in the region while also continuing strong relations with the Freely Associated States and allies throughout the Indo-Pacific. Working toward a common goal, members of this task force form a united front to counter Chinese aggression and ensure America's role and interests in the region remain undiminished.

A Lifetime of FFA Advocacy

Growing up on my family ranch outside Fort Laramie, I learned about the dedication, expertise, and just plain hard work that is required to feed our nation. Like many of you, I joined my peers in "Learning to Do, Doing to Learn; Earning to Live, Living to Serve" and cherish my time as a member of the Lingle-Fort Laramie FFA Chapter in High School.

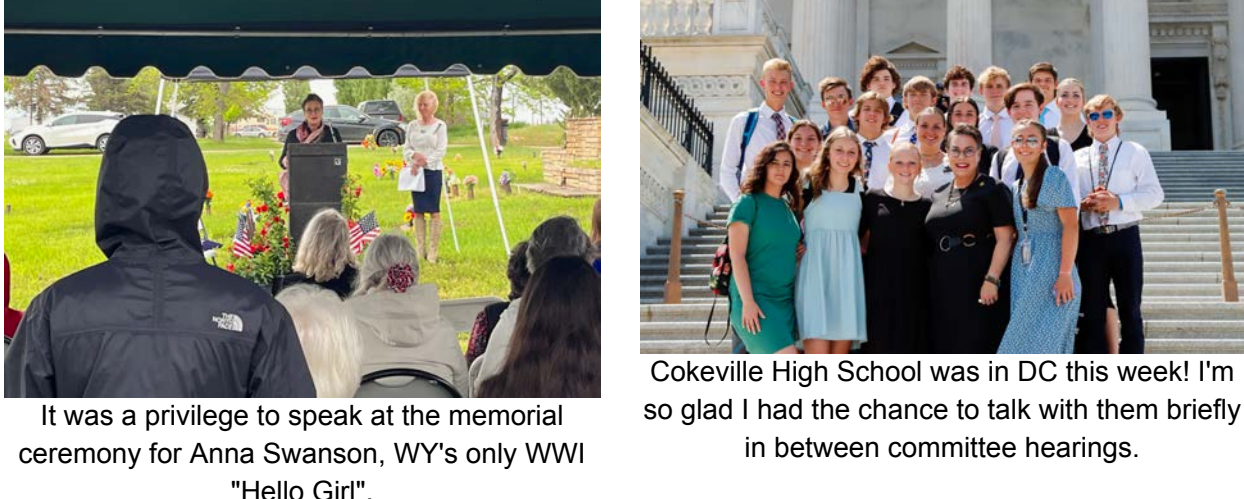

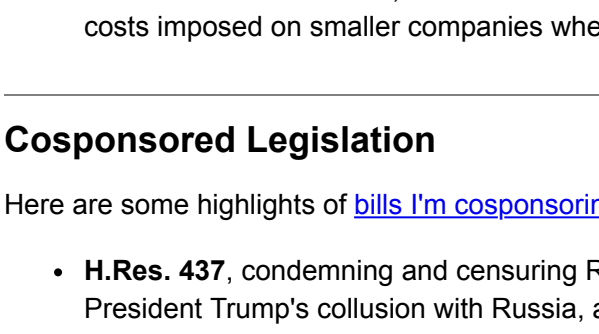

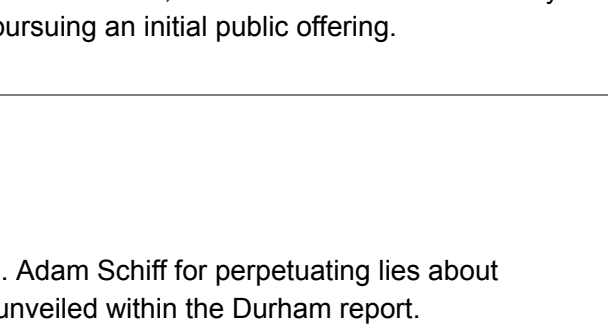

Cosponsored Legislation

Here are some highlights of [bills I'm cosponsoring](#):

- H.Res. 437**, condemning and censuring Rep. Adam Schiff for perpetuating lies about President Trump's collusion with Russia, as unveiled within the Durham report.
- H.R. 3825**, which prohibits the use of DOD funds for adult cabaret performances, drag shows, exotic dances, and similar activities.
- H.R. 3001**, the *Embrace Fossil Fuel Recruitment Act*, which guarantees fossil fuel sector companies the same access to schools for recruitment purposes as any other energy sector business.

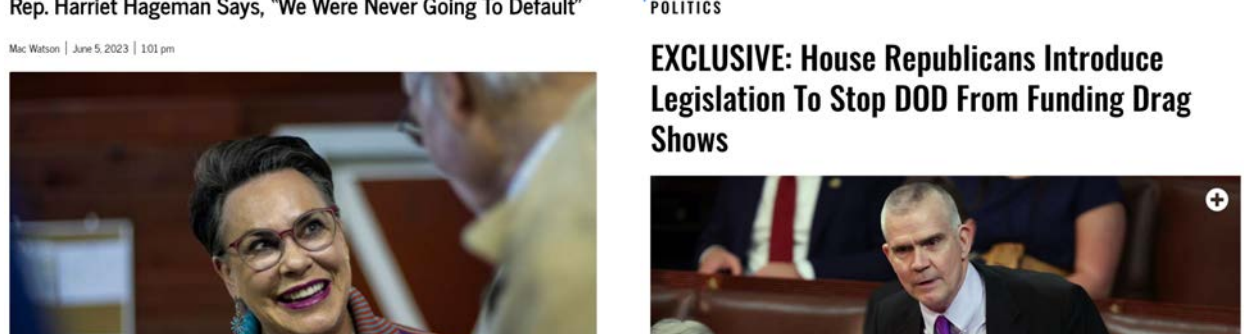

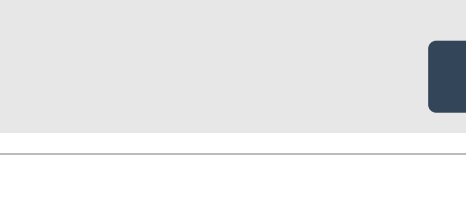

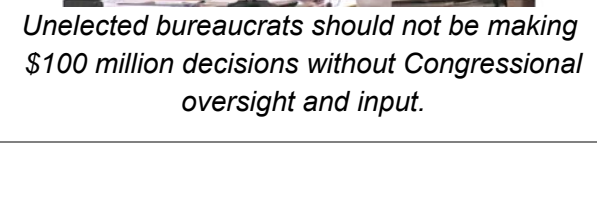
Labeling Republicans, Christian Conservative Groups As Terrorists Is 'Appalling,' Hageman says

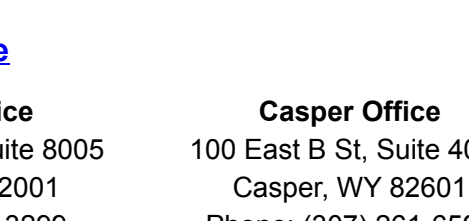
