While the Democrat Shutdown drags on, my work for you continues. I returned to Washington, D.C., last week, participating in a busy series of meetings to identify legislative priorities for the people of Wyoming and to discuss ways in which I can serve you better.

In our newsletter this week, I am providing an update on my ATF advocacy, sharing information on legislation to combat the UN's ongoing efforts to push its climate change agenda, and discussing the reintroduction of my bill, the *Mandatory Country of Origin Labeling Enforcement Act*.

## Upholding Second Amendment Rights—Update on ATF NFA Processing

I recently called upon the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) to take immediate action to restore the processing of National Firearms Act (NFA) applications that had been halted during the government shutdown. These delays prevented law-abiding Americans from exercising their Second Amendment rights, a situation that was simply untenable in light of the Biden administration's concerted efforts to strip us of our right to keep and bear arms. Additional delays in the processing of NFA applications is not acceptable, regardless of whether the Democrats are fighting to keep our government closed.

I am pleased to report that the ATF has agreed to recall its NFA examiners under "excepted status." This decision will allow the agency to resume processing Federal Firearms Licensing (FFL) and NFA forms, and ATF is working to clear the backlog of applications.

I will fight to ensure that Wyoming gun owners are never again used as pawns in political gamesmanship. The Second Amendment is fundamental, not optional.

## Safeguarding American Sovereignty

I am proud to join Republican Study Committee Chairman August Pfluger in introducing the *UNTaxed Act* to prevent the United Nations, through its International Maritime Organization, from imposing a carbon tax on Americans.

The UN will stop at nothing to impose its climate change agenda on the world. I have no intention of allowing that to happen, and I continue to find ways to narrow and constrain the UN's power and authority. By way of example, I fought back against the Biden administration's efforts to impose the UN's natural capital accounting boondoggle on our right to access and use our property and other natural resources. I also recently introduced legislation to protect the American taxpayer from paying climate change "reparations" greenlit by the UN's "International Court of Justice," and I am now partnering with Chairman Pfluger to stop the UN carbon tax.

The UN long outlived its purpose and today operates as a global bureaucracy captured by climate change activism and leftwing politics. It seeks to impose, by bureaucratic dictate, a radical agenda on the U.S., one that Congress refuses to adopt and that the American people have firmly rejected.

The Constitution grants only Congress the authority to lay and collect taxes, and I will always stand up for our Constitution and sovereignty.

## Protecting America's Beef Industry

I am proud to reintroduce the *Mandatory Country of Origin Labeling Enforcement Act* (MCOOL) for beef.

American consumers deserve accurate information about the products they buy, and U.S. ranchers deserve transparent and fair competition in the marketplace. The U.S. abandoned mandatory country-of-origin labeling for beef in 2016 following a ruling by the World Trade Organization. Over those years, the lifting of MCOOL hurt ranchers' profit margins and allowed large packers to blend cheaper foreign beef into the domestic market without proper consumer disclosure. Now that our domestic market is gaining strength, we must protect U.S. independent cattle producers and ensure that consumers know where their beef comes from.

The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) recently released its plan to fortify the American Cattle and Beef Industries. One important component of the USDA's plan includes stricter labeling for products that claim "Product of USA" status. My bill would codify mandatory country-of-origin labeling into law.

By combining the administration's plan with legislative action, we deliver both protection and transparency, ensuring that the premium value of American-raised beef remains in American hands.

### [Military Academy Nominations](#)

My office is currently accepting Military Academy nomination requests through October 31.

Members of Congress may nominate candidates for appointment to four of the five U.S. service academies: U.S. Military Academy (USMA), West Point, NY; the U.S. Naval Academy (USNA), Annapolis, MD; the U.S. Air Force Academy (USFA), Colorado Springs, CO; and the U.S. Merchant Marine Academy (USMMA), Kings Point, NY. The fifth service academy, the U.S. Coast Guard Academy (USCGA), New London, CT, does not require a congressional nomination for appointment.

The honor of attending a service academy comes with the obligation and commitment to serve in the military for a minimum of five years upon graduation.

The 2025 Congressional App Challenge is now accepting applications! Middle and high school students across Wyoming are encouraged to participate in this nationwide competition that helps students learn coding skills and explore opportunities within the STEM and computer science fields.

The Congressional App Challenge is the official computer science competition of the House of Representatives. Since its inception in 2013, it has grown to become the most prestigious prize in computer science. Over 50,000 students have participated in the challenge across 374 Congressional Districts in 50 states and 5 U.S. territories.

#### **Wyoming Coal Combustion Residuals Permit Program**

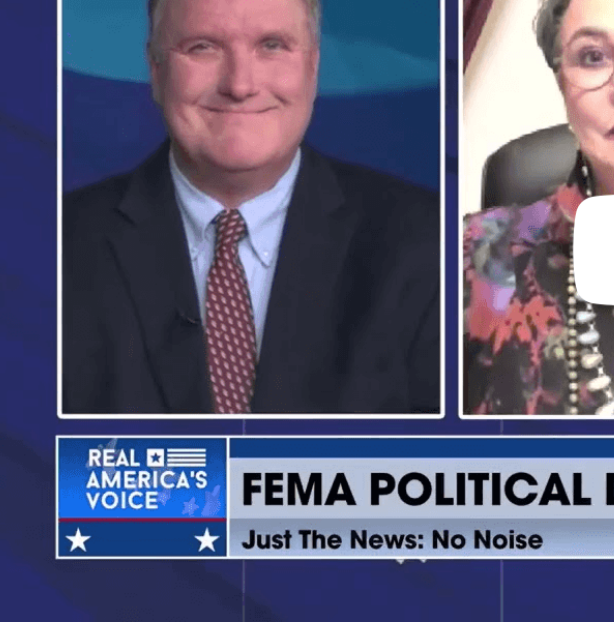
The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is proposing to approve the Wyoming coal combustion residuals (CCR) permit program under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA).

EPA is seeking [comment](#) on this proposal during a 60-day public comment period. Comments must be received on or before November 3, 2025.

#### **Department of the Interior Reopens Regulatory Reform Comment Period**

In May, the Department of the Interior (DOI) issued a request for information on DOI Regulatory Reform. While the original comment deadline ended this summer, the [DOI announced on Tuesday that it was reopening](#) this comment period indefinitely.

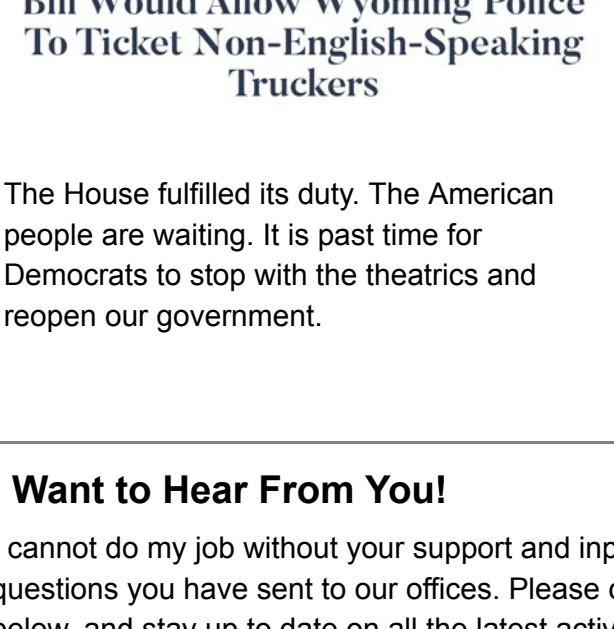


I met with members of Wait List Zero who each gave the gift of life to a stranger by donating their kidney.

Thank you for coming by to share your experiences and discuss your priorities.

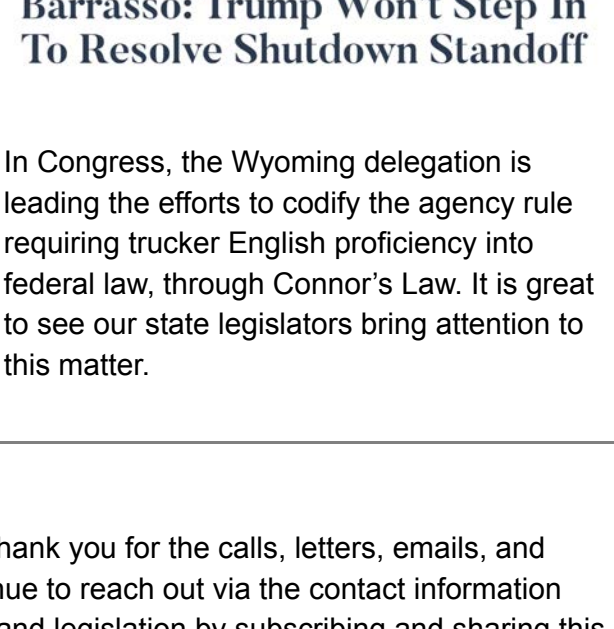


During my meeting with the Society for Public Health and Education, we discussed public health education and its application in Wyoming.
