This coming week the House of Representatives will be back in session, and what a busy month it will be! While much of our effort will be directed towards debating and passing the 12 appropriations bills to fund the government (more on that below), my committees will resume our regular hearing schedule to advance sound legislation and investigate corruption, collusion, conspiracies, overreach, malfeasance, violations of the constitution, and potentially other high crimes and misdemeanors within the Executive Branch.

Ensuring Taxpayer Dollars are Used Properly

As appropriations season in Congress gets underway, I'm actively working to influence and shape our nation's spending bills to return power to state and local governments, and to empower individual citizens, restore sanity to our legislative and legal systems, and ensure Wyoming is given the leeway and authority to thrive. The following are some of the priorities I'm fighting for as we seek to fund the federal government for Fiscal Year 2024:

Department of Defense (DOD) Appropriations:

- It's time that our federal employees return to the office. By mid-2020, roughly 88% of the DOD's 814,000 civilian employees were working remote at least part-time; a 2022 survey showed that 39% of all federal employees teleworked at least 3 days a week. While this raises significant concerns about work productivity and internal communication, it also poses a significant national security threat: approximately 20% of DOD civilians and 26% of DOD contractors hold security clearances. As such, employees are either unable to work on sensitive information while teleworking, or there are potential vulnerabilities created by their working in a less secure setting. As such, I've [sponsored an amendment](#) that will eliminate funds for telework and remote work for DOD civilians and employees.
- The Rocky Mountain Power rate hikes, and California's recurring rolling blackouts, are further proof of the unreliability of intermittent "renewable" energy. Given the immense importance, size, and purpose of our military bases, we need to ensure that their highly technical systems are able to work whenever crisis strikes. That's why I [sponsored an amendment](#) to prevent the use of funds to transition facilities to new fuel sources unless it is proven that the new fuel is as affordable, reliable, and accessible as the source it is replacing.

Department of State, Foreign Operations, and Related Programs Appropriations:


- This appropriations bill will block money from going to John Kerry's climate czar position and defund American participation in the Paris Climate Accord, the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), and much more. These policies, however, are merely the product of the State Department's Office of Global Change (OGC). The OGC is responsible for U.S. policy on climate change internationally and serves as our representative to groups such as the UNFCCC; [my amendment](#) will prevent the OGC from receiving federal funds, blocking these flawed policies before they start.
- Just like the DOD, the State Department is filled with remote work agreements for former DC-based employees who have moved to more affordable areas of the country since they no longer are required to work in-person. Yet despite living in areas with a lower cost of living, these remote work agreements did not adjust locality pay, and often pay employees the higher wage reflective of when they lived in more expensive locations such as California, DC, or New York City. [My amendment](#) will prevent such agreements from being effective if an employee's alternate worksite is outside of the official location that determines their pay.

Legal Assistance for Veteran Families

The Sheridan VA has partnered with Legal Aid of Wyoming to host a free legal clinic for Wyoming's veterans and their spouses. Participants will be able to leave with a completed and verified Will, Power of Attorney, and/or VA Advanced Health Care Directive. The clinic will be held on Thursday, September 21 from 10:30AM – 1:30PM at the Sheridan VA Medical Center Auditorium, Bldg. 61.

Last Call for In-Person Service Academy Briefing






