Also, there is a disagreement among my staff about what is the best Thanksgiving dish. Vote in our poll below to help us elect a winner!

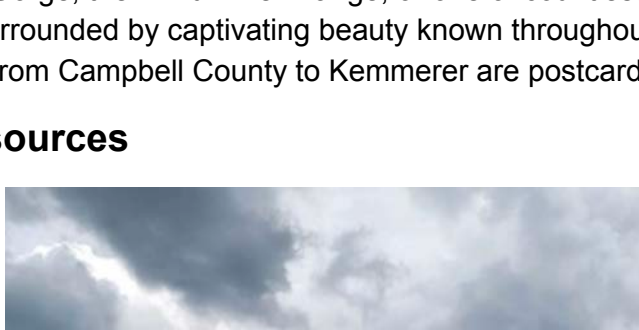

This Job



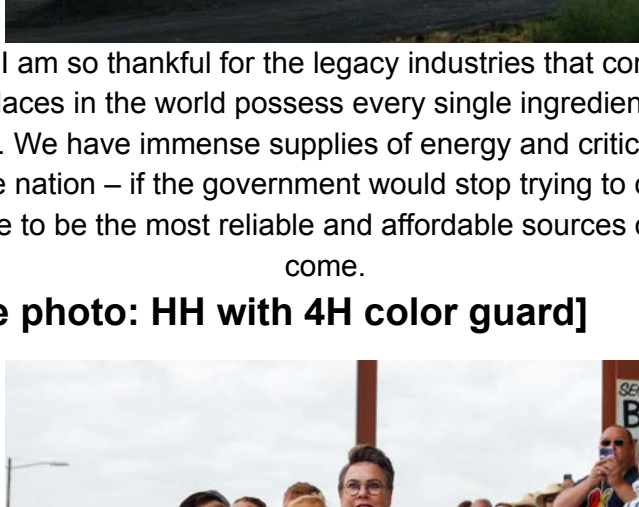

Wyoming's Beauty



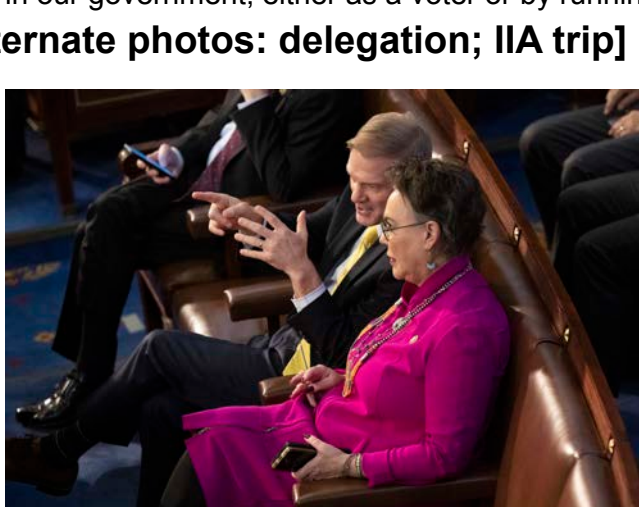

Our Abundant Resources



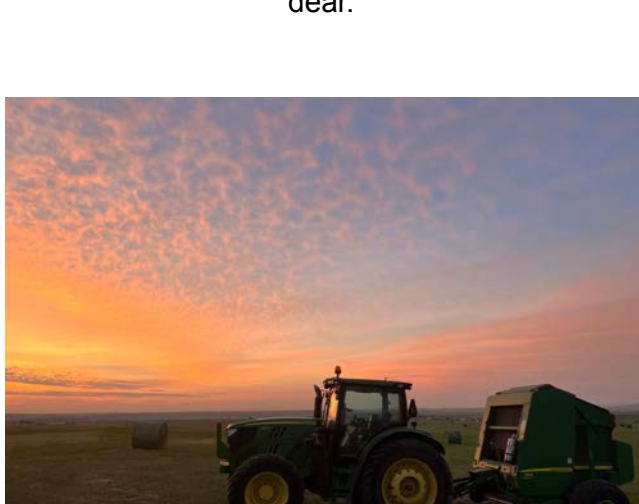

This Year's Moisture!



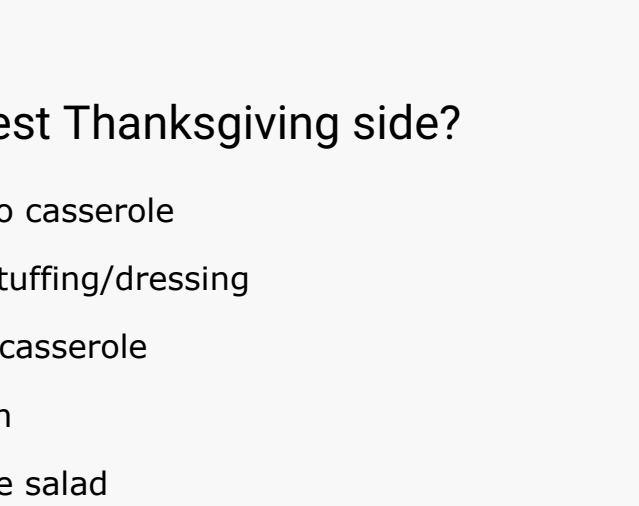

My Family



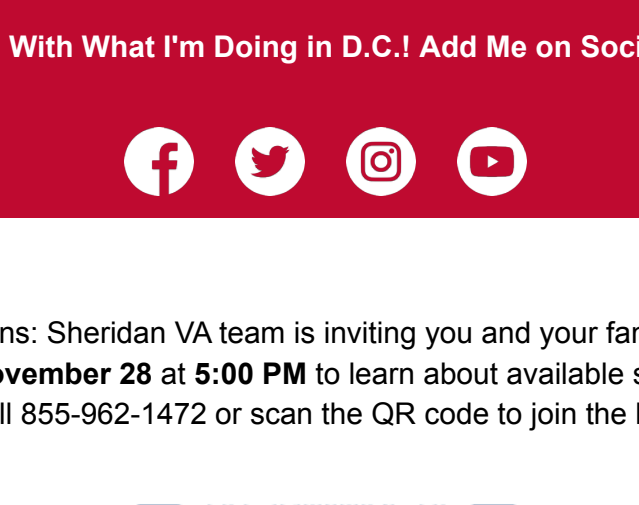

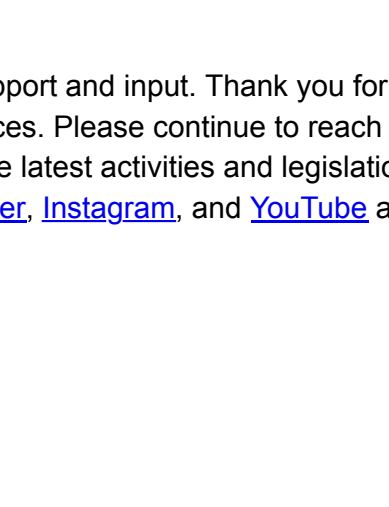
